



Twilight Modular Display Case (Full Size - TDC21)

Replacement Drawer Installation Guide (TDCR21)

Refresh your display with ease. Follow the steps below to replace the acrylic drawer on your full-size Twilight Modular Display Case.

Tools Required

Phillips head screwdriver *(included inside the packaging)*

Replacement Steps

1. Tilt the Case and Extend the Drawer

Carefully tilt the case so that the bottom faces you and the back rests securely on a stable work surface. Pull the acrylic drawer fully forward along the slide rails.

2. Remove the Screws

Using the Phillips head screwdriver, remove the four screws that secure the drawer to the rails.

3. Release and Remove the Old Drawer

Push each release lever on the underside of the slide rails to the left to disengage the drawer and lift the drawer off the rails.

3. Install the New Drawer

Position the new acrylic drawer so that the holes at the bottom align with the holes on the slide rails. Ensure the drawer is seated evenly on both sides and that the release levers are fully engaged.

4. Secure the Drawer and Return the Case Upright

Insert the four screws back into the holes and tighten them securely with the screwdriver. Avoid over-tightening, as this may damage the acrylic or rails. Carefully return the case to its upright position.

Care & Handling

- Ensure screws are snug but not over-tightened to prevent damage to the acrylic or slide rails.
- Handle the acrylic drawer carefully to avoid scratches or cracks.
- Use a soft, lint-free microfiber cloth for cleaning.
- Avoid abrasive materials such as scouring pads, rough towels, or brushes, as they can scratch the surface.
- Do not use harsh chemicals, including ammonia, bleach, or solvent-based cleaners, as they can cause clouding, cracking, or discoloration.
- Keep sharp objects away from acrylic surfaces to prevent scratches.
- Avoid placing extremely hot items directly on the acrylic, as high temperatures can warp or melt it.
